### **SAFE HANDLING INFORMATION**

<b>Storage &amp; Transport:</b>	Not classified under the Transportation of Dangerous Goods Code. Non-flammable and non-combustible. No separate storage section required. Ensure containers are correctly labelled and securely sealed and stowed. Store tightly closed container in a dry area at temperatures between 1-50°C. Store away from strong oxidising agents and acids.
<b>Spills &amp; Leaks:</b>	Observe safety precautions as outlined in "Personal Protection" section. Stop leak. Contain and absorb spills using an inert absorbent material. Pick up with shovel and place in clean, labelled plastic or plastic lined receptacle for disposal or mop-up small spills using mop or sponge. Wash area thoroughly with water. Ensure surface is not slippery afterwards.
<b>Waste Disposal:</b>	Reuse spilled material if possible. Small quantities may be flushed down the sink or toilet. Otherwise, place in plastic container prior to disposing through normal commercial refuse system. Consult Local Council dumps, licensed waste management contractors or the manufacturer for proper disposal method in the event of a major spill. Suitable for incineration.
<b>Fire &amp; Explosion Data:</b>	Non-combustible. Heating can cause expansion leading to rupture of containers. Keep containers cool with water spray. If safe to do so, remove containers from path of fire. Fire fighters to wear self contained breathing apparatus.

#### HEALTH EFFECTS

<b>Swallowed:</b>	May irritate mouth, oesophagus and stomach. Headaches and nausea possible.
<b>Eye:</b>	Concentrated form may be irritant. Inflammation of the eye tissue is characterised by redness, watering and/or itching. Repeated eye exposure may produce chronic inflammation of the eye.
<b>Skin:</b>	Prolonged skin contact in concentrated or diluted form without rinsing may produce skin irritation characterised by redness or itching.
<b>Inhaled:</b>	Not normally an inhalation risk under normal conditions. Excessive inhalation of spray mist may cause slight irritation of throat and possible headaches and nausea.

### TREATMENT

<b>Swallowed:</b>	If swallowed, <b>DO NOT</b> induce vomiting. Give plenty of water to drink. Seek medical attention at once.
<b>Eye:</b>	Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes, occasionally lifting upper and lower lids.
<b>Skin:</b>	Immediately flush contaminated skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation develops.
<b>Inhaled:</b>	In case of over-exposure move exposed person to fresh air. If irritation persists, get medical attention promptly.

### PRECAUTIONS FOR USE:

<b>Exposure Standards:</b>	Not established for product.
<b>Ventilation:</b>	No special measures required.
<b>Personal Protection:</b>	Wear adequate clothing and footwear to prevent skin contact. Remove and launder soiled clothing before re-use. Avoid eye contact. When handling concentrate or large spills, wear approved splash-proof safety glasses and goggles, especially if contact lenses are worn.
<b>Flammability:</b>	Non-flammable. No specific fire hazards associated with this product. No specific ventilation, earthing or flameproofing requirements.
